Transformation is the theme of this oil. For many, this is the turning point in their lives — the Cancer moment when everything changes. She helps with the reorientation of your younger day's and old beliefs from a young age. What do you need?

Venus is in an Water sign right now, This recipe uses the Blue Lotus — one of the most sacred flowers in human history.

In other teachings I explain why each recipe is connected to an specific element, If you have questions you can look into these other teachings.

Note: Blue Lotus oil is rare and precious. If it's not accessible to you, it is perfectly fine to use regular Lotus (white or pink) instead. The essence remains deeply sacred. I order my Blue Lotus directly from India and it takes 3-4 months to be delivered.



Ingredients

For this anointing oil in the element of water we will use:

50ml clean bottle
Castor or Jojoba Oil
what ever you prefer, you can also mix them.

Essential Oils - 2,3% dilution:
For both masculine and feminine energy:

- 18 drops Blue Lotus essential oil
- 3 drops Myrrh essential oil
- 3 drops Myrtle (Gatekeeper) essential oil

Other:
a Candle
Incense
Music instrument
Bowl of water

Safety Note: Always perform a skin test on a small area (inside of wrist) first and wait 24 hours to check for sensitivity. Do not use during pregnancy without consulting an aromatherapist. Avoid contact with eyes and mucous membranes.

The Power of Venus in Cancer

The Gateway of Birth and Return

Cancer holds one of the most profound esoteric secrets: she is the doorway through which souls enter material creation (incarnation) and the doorway through which they return to spirit (ascension).

According to Alice Bailey's esoteric astrology, Cancer stands at both thresholds:

- The door INTO material creation — where spirit takes form
- The door OUT OF material creation — where the resurrected soul returns home

This is why Cancer is called "the door into incarnation" and "the gateway of birth and return." Through Cancer, the soul learns what it means to live in a body, to feel the weight and wonder of form, and ultimately—to transcend it. But Ophiuchus can also be the doorway to home If you have mastered all Archetypes of the zodiac.

The Cosmic Womb

Cancer is a fourth house energy—the house of home, womb, foundation, and belonging. When Venus moves through Cancer, she enters the primordial waters of creation itself—the cosmic womb from which all life emerges and to which all life returns. The perfect time to learn the Divine Mother Womb mantra teachings of Sri Kalishwar for 108 day's.

This is not just about the physical womb—it is about the Cosmic Womb of Mother Elaysa, Mother Sophia, the field in which all of creation exists. When we work with Cancer and the Water element, we are not only healing the water of emotion within us—we are healing the water of Mother Earth herself.

Breaking Generational Patterns

Cancer calls us to:

- Overcome old emotional patterns and rewrite new creations
- Rebuild our vessel, our inner home
- Release ancestral trauma stored in the womb chakra
- Open to divine protection and the nurturing embrace of the Mother

This is the most powerful healing work we can do. Because when we heal the womb, we heal four generations back—our mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and beyond. We break the chains that have held our lineage in pain.

We do NOT have to take on generational patterns. The 4 stem cells from father + 4 stem cells from mother can be overwritten. Layer by layer, we break the "seed of contention."

The Blue Lotus — The Most Sacred Flower in History

Why This Practice Matters Now

The Blue Lotus (*Nymphaea caerulea*) is one of the most sacred flowers in human history. She was used by high priestesses across every continent—most notably in ancient Egypt, India, and among the Maya.

In Egyptian rituals, Blue Lotus oil was a sacred tool for priests and priestesses to enter trance states and access higher realms of knowledge and divine wisdom. There is even an ancient tale where the gods debated over which flower was more beautiful: the Rose or the Blue Lotus.

Today, Blue Lotus oil remains rare and precious. If it is not accessible to you, it is perfectly fine to use regular Lotus (white or pink). The essence remains deeply sacred.

The Egyptian Connection

In ancient Egypt, the Blue Lotus was specifically used to activate the pineal gland—the sacred seat of spiritual vision, the "third eye" that perceives beyond the physical realm. The priests knew that Blue Lotus opened the crown chakra and enhanced spiritual insight and consciousness.

Scientists in Germany discovered Blue Lotus in the tomb of Tutankhamun. They compared the ancient specimen—over 3,600 years old—with Blue Lotus flowers growing today. They found that its frequency remained unchanged. That is why the Blue Lotus is truly a gift from Venus.

Nefertem, born of Sekhmet and Ptah, was the Egyptian God of the Blue Lotus (700 BC). In Greece, the goddess Praksikleia (540 BC) was also associated with this sacred flower. When held to the face, the Blue Lotus was considered a blessing.

Properties of Blue Lotus

- Opens the third eye and enhances spiritual vision
- Activates the pineal gland for higher perception
- Connects to the crown chakra and expands spiritual insight
- Soothes the nervous system and releases emotional blockages
- Awakens Kundalini energy and intuitive understanding
- Helps navigate emotions from a higher perspective without drowning
- Supports dreamwork, visions, and astral travel
- Balances masculine and feminine within (Hierogamic Union)
- Fills in the gaps of junk DNA and helps rewrite it (serotonin & aporphine)
- Used in initiations and pineal gland openings (7 life-changing openings)

The Divine Feminine Connection

This flower is intimately connected with the Goddess Isis and the Divine Feminine, embodying compassion, intuition, sacred sexuality, and ancient rites. She helps us balance the masculine and feminine energies within, facilitating what is known as Hierogamic Union—the sacred union of opposites in harmony.


The Oil Carries Codes

The codes in the oil resonate with the codes in your field. When you anoint, a recognition takes place — cell by cell, layer by layer. What lay dormant is awoken. What was forgotten is remembered.

The Journaling

Journaling opens doors you might prefer to keep closed. That is precisely the intention. The questions are not a test, but a mirror. They invite you to look honestly at patterns you unconsciously repeat: where you seek control out of fear, where you hide anger behind kindness, where you still wait for recognition from outside. This is not judgment — this is liberation.

Why Oil is Sacred Water

"Oil doesn't just transform your karma like fire does. It washes your subtle bodies clean, layer by layer, emotion by emotion, lifetime by lifetime."

We remember to burn candles for ceremony. Fire is easy to understand—it burns karma, it transforms, it is light made visible.

But we forgot about the water element, which oil represents.

Fire burns, yes. But water cleanses. Fire transforms. But water restores. Only water can wash you clean. Only water can flush emotions and purify them.

This is why oil—as the embodiment of the water element—is just as important as burning a candle. Fire and water together create the most powerful purification in ceremony.

The Daily Anointing

Who Are You Really?

Each drop on your forehead is a reminder: I am more than this body, more than these thoughts, more than these emotions. The oil works not through magic from outside, but by activating your own consciousness. She tells you what you actually already know but have forgotten.

Expect no fireworks. Expect subtlety. Like clarity in the middle of the day. Or a dream that brings answers. A conversation that comes precisely when you need it. A synchronicity you cannot ignore.

Expect no fireworks. Expect subtlety. A sudden clarity in the middle of the day. A dream that brings answers. A conversation that comes precisely when you need it. But also expect intensity: emotions rising to the surface, old pain wanting to be seen, patterns finally breaking. The oil opens the field — your higher self and the spirit of the oil do the rest together.

The Teaching of Sri Kaleshwar

According to the teachings of Sri Kaleshwar, water washes away karma and the old. When we use water and oil together in ceremony, we are engaging in the most ancient form of purification—one that cleanses not just the body, but the soul itself.

When we anoint ourselves with oil that has been baptized in sacred water, we are literally washing away:

- Old emotional patterns
- Karmic residue from past lifetimes
- Ancestral trauma stored in the womb
- Distorted programs in our energy field
- The imprints of victim-victimizer consciousness

The Ceremony

✓ Baptism in Sacred Waters

This ceremony uses the ancient Essene water ritual combined with the teachings of Sri Kaleshwar to sanctify the oil. Water washes away karma and the old—oil seals in the new.

✓ What You Will Need

- A bowl of coconut water (or spring water/blessed water)
- Your 50ml bottle
- Blue Lotus, Myrtle (and Myrrh for men) essential oils
- White Castor oil
- A clean white cloth or towel
- Rose water (hydrosol) for hand purification (optional)
- A candle and scarf
- Your journal

✓ Preparation

Sit facing East (the direction of wisdom). In Hebrew and Essene traditions, rose water was used to wash the hands and face before ritual. If you have rose water, cleanse your hands and face now.

Light your candle. Place your right hand on your heart, your left hand on your womb (reverse if male). Take three deep breaths.

The Ceremony - Sacred space

Beloved Presence, Unutterable Absolute God Source—the One Living Light that moves through all seen and unseen worlds—we gather here now to open the sacred light channels between You, our souls, and the Divine Essence within the Oils.


Let each fiber of Light within us be re-attuned to the Original Living Code, the Infinite Geometry of Divine Design that breathes through all creation.

We call upon the Water from Mother's Womb—the Aah-QuA'-el—the eternal water flow of all liquids. We invite the Aurora Light Streams to weave in harmony with the Infinite Krystic Sun.

May this oil serve the highest good. May it guide us deeper into the sacred waters of our own soul. May it magnify our devotions and amplify our intentions.

We seal this space in Truth, in Grace, in Sovereignty. And so it is. Thank You, God.

Chant: Thah-A-Jha-Inta-Do'A (3 times)

Blessing the Water

Hold your bowl of coconut water in both hands. Bring it to your womb chakra.
Close your eyes.



Beloved God, Beloved Mother Sophia, we gather here in reverence, with humble and aching gratitude for the sacred, life-sustaining gift of water.

From water, all life is born. All breath begins. We ask You now—bless this water, this holy vessel of life, that nourishes the Earth, her roots, her rivers, her womb; that cradles the beings of the deep, the elementals, the creatures, the human hearts that walk upon her skin.

May this water remember its original purity. May it flow with the wisdom of creation itself.

Chant: Ka Ra Ya Sa Ta Ha La (3 times)

Feel the sacred fire of the Seven Suns entering the water

09 The Purification Ritual

Dip the white cloth into the blessed water (do not soak it—just dampen it). Now sprinkle the cloth seven times over yourself, your altar, and your space.

As you sprinkle, visualize all illusions dissolving, all weight washing away. Water washes away karma and the old.

Water Mantra of Sri Kaleshwar (6 times):

Om Varuna Devaya Namaha

Womb Mantra of Sri Kaleshwar (6 times):

Om dim ram, dim ram, dim ram mama kama chakra praksalana ava ham

Creating the Oil

1. Place your oil bottle into the bowl of blessed water
2. Hold it to your womb space
3. Pour the Castor oil into the bottle (while it sits in the water)
4. Add Blue Lotus (21 drops), counting each one with reverence
5. Add Myrrh (2 drops) if male
6. Add Myrtle (3 drops) for all
7. Close the bottle and hold it in both hands

Dear God, baptize this oil in Your name. This Sacred Blue Lotus oil is now in perfect peace and harmony with all things. It will help me overcome family patterns and look at them from the higher planes.

Breathe into the bottle three times—from your heart, from your womb.



10 Anointing Yourself

Take the bottle out of the water. Dry it gently with the cloth. Pour 12 drops into your palm. Rub your hands together. Set your intention to heal your emotional waters and ancestral patterns.

Anoint your body in this order:

1. Womb chakra (2nd)

"I honor the primordial womb powers within me. I am the vessel of the Mother. I create only from divine alignment."

2. Heart chakra (4th)

"May my heart be healed. May the Kryst lineage be healed. May all suppressed feminine energy be healed upon the Earth."

3. Throat chakra (5th)

"May the voice of my soul express itself through sound—my true sound."

4. Third Eye (6th)

"May the veil be removed. May my vision be awoken in this new journey."

5. Crown (7th)

"I am open to receive the influx of divine information. My soul anchors in this embodiment."

6. Tailbone

"I overwrite all old family patterns and crack open the seed of contention"

7. Feet

"I bless my path and journey. I am carried by the Mother with every step."



The Womb Speaks

Sit in silence. Place both hands on your womb.

I am the vessel of the Mother. I am held. I am safe. I navigate my emotions with grace. I rise from the mud like the Lotus—pure, radiant, and free.

Thank you, Venus. Thank you, Water. And so it is.

Daily Practice



This meditation is designed to help you connect with your wholeness, awaken your Kundalini, and remember your true nature. You can practice it before or after anointing, or as a standalone meditation whenever you need to return to center

Preparation

Integrate the energy of Venus in Scorpio into your daily life with this simple practice.

Morning

Apply one drop of oil to your forehead. Speak your intention for the day. Take three conscious breaths.

During the Day

When you are challenged, remind yourself: "I am here to learn. What triggers me shows me where growth is possible."

Evening

Apply one drop of oil to your neck/thymus. Speak: "I receive everything I need to recharge and restore myself."

1. Anoint daily with Blue Lotus oil, focusing especially on your womb chakra
2. Use the journal prompt from your highest-scoring theme

4. Trust the process—the Blue Lotus will guide you through the mud to the light

Note: If you have multiple high scores, start with the one that feels most emotionally charged. The themes are interconnected—healing one often heals the others.

Notes for Your Journey

- If you cry during this ceremony, let the tears flow. They are the waters of release.
- If you feel resistance, it means you are touching something deep. Be gentle with yourself.
- Anoint your womb daily during this transit to continue the healing.
- This is ancestral work—you are healing not just yourself, but your entire lineage (4 generations back).
- Save 1/5th of this oil in your Sacred Womb Oil jar for the final blend.
- Leave the white cloth outside in the sun or moonlight after ceremony to be further purified.

The Right Ear Teaching

It is believed that until the age of 7, your right ear is the dominant ear of fear.

When parents or teachers reprimanded you, it may have planted seeds of an internal critical voice—a judgmental tone that now overrides your once vibrant and healthy inner child.

If you continue to carry feelings of guilt, self-suppression, or remain entangled in victim-victimizer patterns, this inner pain can manifest as illness. The oils assist in repairing these destructive energetic imprints and help peel away the false layers that have formed around your wounded inner child.

The Commitment to Yourself

Now comes the most important part: the daily commitment to remember. Knowledge without practice remains theoretical. Understanding without application does not create transformation. You must choose, again and again, to show up for yourself.

Your Daily Anointing process

This means anointing yourself daily, even when it feels silly or unnecessary. This means meditating regularly, even when your mind resists stillness. This means journaling about your relationships, even when the insights are uncomfortable. This means choosing compassion over judgment, even when judgment feels more satisfying in the moment.

There will be days when you forget. Days when you fall back into old patterns of blame, victimhood, or separation. This is normal. This is part of the process. The question is not whether you will stumble. The question is: Will you get back up? Will you return to your practice? Will you choose remembrance once again?
